66 pc Green **Cover Lost in** 40 Yrs: Study

Bangalore: A study by the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board (KSPCB) and the Indian Institute of Science (IISc) has found that vegetation in Bangalore has decreased by 66 per cent and water bodies by 74 per cent in the last 40 years. Prof TV Ramachandran of

IISC's Centre for Environ-ment Sciences presented the study conducted by his team and KSPCB at a press confer-

ence here.

The study was done through remote sensing techniques and its analysis says the spatial extent of tree vegetation in Bangalore is 100.02 sq km (14.08 per cent). Vegetation is mini-mum in wards such as Chickpet, Shivajinagar, Kempap-ura Agrahara and Padararayanapura with less than hundred trees while wards such as Varthur, Bellandur and Agaram have higher vegetation cover of more than 300 hectares. Hoody, Ara-mane Nagara and Vasantha Pura have even higher veg-etation. The total number of trees in Bangalore is about 14,78, 412 and the number is

ecreasing. The study adds that the computation of trees per person shows that Shivajina Dayananada Nagar, Chick-pet, Padarayanapura and Kempapura Agrahara wards have less than one tree for

every 500 people. Intra city analyses show that major cities such as Gandhinagar have 416 trees for every 100 people followed by Bangalore with 17 trees, Briban Mumbai with 15 trees and Ahmedabad with 11

Urban vegetation plays a vital role as it moderates the micro climate of the city and tained and used later by plants in life processes as well as aids in the percolation of water. WHO recommends a minimum green space of 9.5 sq meter per-son. Estimates indicate that about six tons of carbon are sequestered by 1 hectare of forests annually and this accounts for 6 kg per tree per

The study says reduced vegetation cover with urban-ization has serious implications for the city's environ mental and ecological health. TV Ramachandran conclud-ed: "This highlights that the city has crossed the threshold of urbanization, which is

Intracity analyses show that major cities such as Gandhinagar have 416 trees for every 100 people followed by Bangalore with 17 trees

evident from a range of psy-chological, social and health impacts on residents including dramatic increase in obe-sity, asthma, traffic prob-lems, road accidents etc. Urban planners must maintain at least 33 per cent green cover which means at least 15 trees per person in the

city." Ramachandran also said: The level of environmental literacy is low in the city. We must hold workshops for ca-pacity building and after citizens become sensitive to our ecological needs, they will surely help preserve our ecosystems." KSPCB Chair-man Vaman Acharya said: "Let us plant at least one tree per person in the city. Only this can help."

Street Lights: Contractors to be Fined

Bangalore: BBMP's Wardcontemplating to impose a fine of ₹1.000 on contractors in each ward for poor main-tenance of street lights. Committee Chairman A H Basavaraju, who along with

officials went on an inspection drive in various parts of the city on Wednesday night, said a fine amount of ₹79,200 was imposed on erring contractors. The committee members

inspected Kempegowda Road, Mysore Bank Circle, Palace Road, T V Tower Road, Cantonment, Queens Road, Subbaiah Circle, Lalhogh Road, Kanakapura Road, Bannerghatta Road and other areas. "The com-mittee received complaints about streetlights and we went to these places. Street-lights were not working in most areas and in some plac-es even high mast lights were not functioning. In the South zone alone, we imposed a penalty of ₹65,100, ₹7,100 in East zone and ₹7,000 in West zone. A penalty of ₹79,200 was imposed on 18 tender packages," Basavarajusaid

Warning the erring con tractors of terminating their contracts, he said: "Notices that have bagged the tenders and have failed in their work. blacklisted. The committee will hence-

forth impose a fine of ₹1,000 on contractors who do not switch on streetlights in the evening. The committee officials found that streetlights neas round that streetings in good condition were not switched on in some places. This is a sufficient reason to impose a fine.

"Based on the suggestions from the Technical Vigilance

Cell under Commissione (IVCC), the committee will float new tenders for main-tenance of streetlights", Basavaraju added.
