Monsoon intensifies in Western Ghats, coast

Bangalore to Bhubaneswar

Bengaluru/Karwar/shivamogga, July 09, 2015, DHNS:



The south-western monsoon has revived in the Western Ghats and two coastal districts - Dakshina Kannada and Udupi - in the last two days.

The Ghat sections in the Malnad region and the coastal districts have received very heavy rains, and the condition may continue for the next couple of days, according to G S Srinivasa Reddy of the Karnataka State Natural Disaster Monitoring Centre.

Reddy on Wednesday said Hettu hobli in Sakleshpur taluk, Hassan district, received 155 mm (15.5 cm) of rain from Tuesday till 4.30 pm on Wednesday. "Anything above 124 mm is considered as very heavy rainfall. In Hassan, it is Sakaleshpur which is receiving the rains," he said.

Reddy said that there is nothing unusual about the rains during this season. However, heavy rains are lashing the Ghats and parts of the Malnad region. Thirthahalli hobli in Agumbe has recorded about 140 mm (14 cm). As many as 25 rain-gauging stations have recorded not less than 50 mm rainfall in Dakshina Kannada. Even Udupi is receiving heavy rains. However, Kodagu is receiving only moderate rains, he pointed out.

The officer said that the coastal districts and the Ghat sections would continue to receive heavy rains for the next couple of days.

Rains receded in Uttara Kannada district on Wednesday with Karwar and Siddapur receiving a drizzle. In the last 24 hours, the district has received 73.4 mm of rain. It has rained 60.2 mm in the month of July. Ankola has registered a rainfall of 7.4 mm, Bhatkal 8 mm, Kumta 16.2 mm and Honnavar 7.7 mm of rain till July 8.

After a brief lull, moderate to heavy rain lashed some parts of Shivamogga district on Wednesday. Thirthahalli, Hosanagar, some parts of Sagar, Shivamogga, Shikaripur and Sorab received rain. Intermittent rain lashed various parts of Thirthahalli taluk throughout the day. The road near Mandagadde connecting Shivamogga and Thirthahalli was waterlogged causing inconvenience for motorists.
