

BMP officials inspect civil works

Bangalore, Nov 29: BMP administrator Dilip Rao undertook an inspection of the ongoing infrastructure projects in the city.

It has been announced that he would hold public grievance meetings at his office every Monday between 3 pm to 5 pm.

Meanwhile, BMP Commissioner K Jairaj reviewed the markets department on Wednesday and directed officials to draft an action plan for reconstruction and development of Public Utility Building, Jayanagar 4th block, Symphony theater and Puttanna Kanagal theater.

A 10-point programme for improved

utilisation of these areas has also been formulated.

A review of road development works under Karnataka Municipal Reforms Project was carried out and deadlines set for completion of work. Work on the Koramangala 80-foot road is likely to be completed by December 12, Mission road-Langford road by November 30, Kamm-anahalli by December 15, Magadi road by January 31 and Kathriguppe road by December 31.

Agencies working on the J P Nagar 3rd phase road have been fined while the contract for Bannerghatta road has been terminated due to lack of progress, a release from BMP said.
