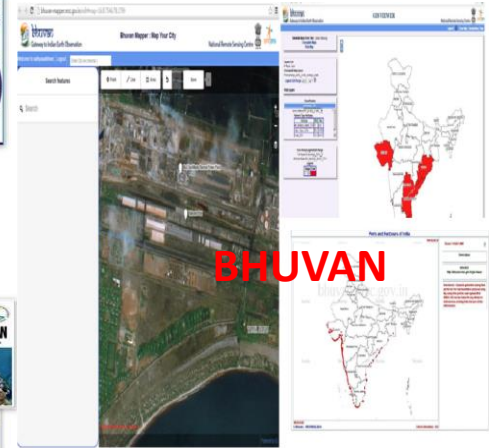

- Providing District-wise database with the incorporation of District Maps.
- Updating of general statistics about the coastal states of India [as and when it becomes available from diverse sources].
- Portraying the Ecologically Sensitive Areas of the coastal states of India.
- Develop a preliminary district level database on Indian coastal states which includes information's about the coastal population, fish landing centre's, diversity of fishes, fish catch, fishing crafts, trend in fishing activities, merits and demerits of technology used in fishing activities, coastal shelter belts and research programs undertaken in these coastal stretches.
- Creating an inventory for coastal developments – Ports and Harbours etc.
