 - Fauna of Bangalore
- ENVIS Centre Karnataka has a dedicated website at <http://parisaramahiti.kar.nic.in> hosted by NIC Bangalore (2012)
- In 2013, KARENVIS website was hosted on CMS portal and redesigned and restructured by EMPRI-ENVIS. The website has been maintained till date.
