- b) I want to make a network of NGOs in my State (Odisha) in all 30 districts by establishing a 'Nodal Centre' at Bhubaneswar, will identify retired graduate and post graduate faculties in various colleges (district level, having atleast little bit of volunteering mindset) to create awareness on ecosystem and its importance for school children, farmers, women and youths (the sole objective is to make all of them to understand how important is it to conserve, preserve and manage the natural habitats and resources.
